Ms. Stanberry:

I'm sure Representative Clarke, who has been very concerned about the electric grid, would be interested to know that a Chinese transformer company claims that 10% of New York City's electric load goes through their transformers. As you know, the supply chain cybersecurity of the electric grid has been a major concern since SoalrWinds and the seizure of a Chinese transformer by the federal government. One of the Chinese companies that exports transformers to the U.S. is JiangSu HuaPeng Transformer Co., Ltd. (Ironically, it was one of this company's transformers that was seized by the federal government and taken to Sandia National Laboratories.)

Here is their page on US/Canada exports: <http://www.jsHP.com/usa-canada.html>. They claim: "Over a hundred of JSHP transformers has been delivered to USA/Canada since 2009." (Website has pictures, locations and customers of several.) The company's press releases (attached) give details, and pictures including the claim in 2018 that "JSHP supports 10% of the NYC load!"

I have discovered from U.S. International Trade Commission data that the U.S. has imported at least 300 large power transformers from China since 2006. See: [The U.S. Has 300 Chinese Large Power Transformers](#).

We need the House to hold hearings on the issue of electric grid supply chain cybersecurity and, specifically, on the safety of transformers imported from a country with a history of hacking the electric grid.
