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Basis for Intervening:

The Large Public Power Council (LPPC) represents 27 of the largest state and municipally-owned utilities in the nation. The members comprise the larger, asset-owning utilities in the public power community, owning approximately 90 percent of the transmission assets owned by non-federal public power entities. LPPC members are located throughout the nation, both within and outside RTO boundaries, and they are subject to the Commission's electric reliability authority and regulations under Federal Power Act (â€œFPAâ€) section 215.

As utilities subject to the Commission's electric reliability rules and regulations, including NERC's mandatory electric reliability standards, LPPC members as well as the consumers they serve will be directly impacted by any action taken by the Commission in this proceeding regarding the August 26, 2021 Complaint filed by Michael Mabee in this proceeding. LPPC seeks to intervene in this proceeding to represent the interests of these members. LPPC, then, has an interest in the outcome of this proceeding, and its involvement in this matter will promote the public interest. Good cause therefore exists for this motion, and LPPC requests that the Commission grant its motion to intervene in this proceeding.
